OF
THE INDIAN MISSION CHURCH
GRAND TRAVERSE BAY, MICHIGAN
BY
REV. PETER DOUGHERTY

Saturday June 3rd, 1843.

On this day was organized a mission Church under the care of the old School General Assembly's Board of Foreign Missions. At $\frac{1}{2}$ past 2 OC [lock] (sic) a meeting was held in the school house and the following persons were enrolled as members in full communion.

Mr Henry Bradley was unanimously elected as an elder in this Church. Mr. Bradley was not ordained having been ordained as an elder in the Church at the Weah Mission.

Sabbath 4th Celebrated the Lord's Supper this day

Three were received by letter from the Methodist Episcopal Church, Bermingham (Sic) circuit, Detroit district, viz Mr. Walter Drake, Mrs. Adaline Drake and Miss Harriet Hall.

Four members were suspended from church privilege for drinking, viz Emma Allen. Elizabeth, Phebe and Henry one viz Mary Downey on confession and repentance was restored.

On the 4th Sabbath of July children were baptized

1845 Jany 4 On this day being the first Sabbath of the year we celebrated the Lord's Supper. One native woman was examined and received to church fellowship and was baptized. She received the name of Susan (sic) Her Indian name was Ke wa yon. Susan Duglass was also received on examination Babezha (Agnes) brought one child for Baptism (sic) She was named Jane about 6 ys (sic) of age.

Died on the 7th of Jany 1845 Elizabeth Potts the wife of the Chief.

May 18th 1845 This day the Lord's Supper was administered (sic) One native woman daughter of the Chief was received to fellowsh (sic) and baptized. Her Indian name is Mis suh nah ne qud sic She received the Christian name of Ellen

Three children were baptized, (sic) The Chief Addison Potts presented one which was baptized receiving the name of George Hale.

Kah ge and Se be qua presented an adopted child which was

June 1846 This day Sabbath we commemorated the death of
 the Lord Jesus in the sacrament (sic) of the supper. Two
 members of the church viz Mo kue nah (Daniel Wells) and his wife
 Guaquejeahnoqua (sic) (Phebe Wells) were kept back for improper
 conduct. Charles Fisher and Henry Gahgee or Crow who were suspend-
 ed at the last communion for drinking, were on confession restored
 but did not present themselves. Joseph Shahwuhnakshe was prevent-

 sacrament (sic) of the Lord's Supper was commemorated by the church
 at this place (sic) No additions were made to the church

May 23 This day Mr. Henry Bradley elder of this church and
 Susan Duglass a member of this church and sister of Mrs. Bradley
 were publically suspended from the privileges of this church for

illicit intercourse. Mr. Bradley made a public confession in the church.

May 1847 Mr. Walter Drake and his wife and Miss Harriet Hall by their own request received letters of dismissal from this church Also Mrs. Sarah Bradley

Dec. 26th 1847 This day being the last Sabbath of the year the Communion (sic) of the Lord's Supper was administered. Twenty three comts (sic) were present. Three natives were baptized and added to the church viz.

Sabbath May 5th 1861 the memorial of the death of Christ was observed this day. 3 persons viz Geo H Ahgosa Mary Ann Allen & Mrs Mary Petosega were received in to commun (sic) of this church on confession of faith. Mrs Petosega was baptized having been brought up in the catholic church These three Individuals had been members of the school at Grove Hill. Nashkaze & wife presented in the afternoon one child for baptism She was named Nancy

John C L Kesis had his child presented for baptism the last sabbath of May She was named Jane

Sabbath Oct 6th 1861 This day the sacrement (sic) was administered. Forty two communicants presented themselves In the afternoon Memgowene & wife presented one child for baptism about 3 weeks old named Sophene Mr & Mrs Craker presented one named Alonzo Custer

Sabbath Jany 5th 1862 This day we had our regular communion Rev Geo.N. Smith of North Port preached, a portion of his people was present no person was united to the church. forty (sic) persons set^(sic) down to the celebration of the Saviour's death. In the afternoon David & Mary Muhdwagonan (sic) she had a child baptized named Benjamin Alfred Mezhenushkodawa (sic) one named George Henry Joseph & Mary Jane Tabakkeah (sic) one named Sophia
